Availability

A primary responsibility is to prioritize for specific relationships. This requires a willingness to be available to meet each others needs.

Confidentiality

For authenticity to occur, members must be able to trust that issues discussed are not to be shared outside the group.

Multiplication

Group members recognize that one of the goals of their group is to start a new group. One way to do this is by the apprentice/coordinator process. This allows others to experience the Connect Group relationship.
